Information for Participants

1. Venue

The second meeting of the Ad Hoc Open-ended Working Group on Access and Benefit-Sharing (ABS) and the Ad Hoc Open-ended Inter-sessional Working Group on Article 8 (j) and Related Provisions of the Convention on Biological Diversity will be held back-to-back in Montreal from Monday, 1 to Friday, 5 December, and Monday, 8 to Friday, 12 December 2003, respectively.

2. Registration and Identification Name Badges

Delegates participating in both the ABS and Article 8(j) meetings are kindly encouraged to avail themselves of the opportunity to collect their name badges for the Article 8 (j) meeting on *Thursday, 4 December* and *Friday, 5 December 2003*.

Delegates should pre-register using the attached forms, **annex A** for the meeting of the Working Group on Access and Benefit-sharing and **annex B** for the meeting of the Working Group on Article 8 (j), to minimize delays and confusion caused by on-site registration. Based on the received and duly completed pre-registration forms, badges will be prepared and handed over at the Registration Desk **only** upon the presentation of a valid piece of identification with a photograph.

Delegates are kindly reminded that for security reasons display of name badges is necessary for admission to the ICAO Conference Centre as well as the meeting rooms. In addition, delegates are requested to have personal identification documents (passport or other official documents with photograph) for entry into the conference centre.

Information pertaining to room allocations for the plenary and the two working groups as well as regional group meeting rooms will be made available on site.

3. Official opening

The official opening of the meeting of the Working Group on Access and Benefit-sharing will take place on Monday, 1 December 2003, at 10 a.m.

The official opening of the Working Group on Article 8 (j) will take place on Monday, 8 December 2003, at 10 a.m.

4. Documents

All delegates are kindly reminded to bring their own copies of the pre-session documents, including the Information documents. For reasons of economy, Parties and Governments <u>only</u> shall be provided with <u>one set</u> of documents per delegation.

CD-ROMs containing pre-session documents in the six United Nations official languages and information documents shall also be available to delegates and other participating organizations who wish to reproduce additional copies of documents. These could be obtained from the Documentation Counter and the copies could be made on <u>commercial basis</u> at the Business Centre at the venue of the meeting.

5. Services to delegates

Within the ICAO Conference Centre, there will be a Business Centre that will provide, on commercial basis, the following services: photocopying, facsimile and the sale of stamps and telephone prepaid cards, etc.

Delegates may also access their e-mails, *free of charge*, at the Cyber Café situated within the ICAO Conference Centre.

Montreal is 5 hours behind GMT.

11. Weather information

During the month of December in Montreal, maximum temperatures average 2°C and minimum temperatures average **minus** 10°C. Temperatures may drop to **minus** 20°C and snowfalls are frequent and may be heavy.

It should be noted that the Government of Canada will provide, *on a no-cost loan basis*, and for the duration of the meetings, winter coats and boots to interested participants attending the meetings.

12. Electricity

110 volts, 60 Hertz. Adapters can be purchased for about C\$ 50.

13. Currency

The currency in Canada is Canadian Dollar (C\$). The current exchange rate is C\$ 1.37 to US\$ 1.
