NOTIFICATION

Request to developing countries and countries with economies in transition to assess and submit to the Secretariat information on their capacity-building needs and priorities for effective implementation of the Biosafety Protocol

Madam/Sir.

The CBD Secretariat has embarked on an exercise to assist countries to assess their capacity-building needs and priorities for the effective implementation of the Biosafety Protocol, and to make this information available through the Biosafety Clearing-House (BCH).

Information provided will be useful in developing a general understanding of the priority capacities required for the effective implementation of the Protocol in order to develop strategic measures to address those needs. In addition, registering national needs and priorities of developing countries and countries with economies in transition in the central BCH database would enable donor countries and organizations in a position to offer assistance to readily access this information. This would facilitate a more systematic targeting of available donor assistance towards the specific country-defined needs and priorities.

This process is being conducted as part of the ongoing implementation of recommendations made by the Intergovernmental Committee for the Cartagena Protocol on Biosafety (ICCP). The Action Plan for Building Capacities for the Effective Implementation of the Protocol, which was endorsed by the ICCP, requires Parties and Governments to identify and prioritize their national capacity needs and to sequence actions for the implementation of the Action Plan prior to the first meeting of the Conference of the Parties serving as the meeting of the Parties to the Protocol (COP-MOP). Consequently, the ICCP requested the Secretariat to develop and maintain in the BCH a page where countries can readily access information on available capacity-building support, and where those requiring support could indicate their specific capacity-building needs.

In order to assist all countries to submit information in a consistent manner, and to facilitate future searching of the database, a common format for registering information on capacity-building needs and priorities has been prepared, based on the elements identified in the capacity-building Action Plan. I recognize that some countries may still be in the early stages of undertaking a full assessment of their capacity-building needs as part of the surveys being undertaken through the UNEP/GEF project on the Development of National Biosafety Frameworks. However, I encourage all countries to register whatever information is currently available, with the view to updating their records as new information is collected.

Attachment I

Procedures for submitting identified national biosafety capacity-building needs and priorities to the CBD Secretariat and the Biosafety Clearing-House

There are two options for submitting information to the Secretariat and the Biosafety Clearing-House (BCH). Countries with a registered National Focal Point for the BCH can register their information directly with the BCH database using the online forms available through the Management Centre (see option (a) below for detailed instructions). Countries without a BCH National Focal Point can fill in the attached common format and send it to the Secretariat for incorporation in the BCH (see option (b) below).

It would be appreciated if information could be submitted before Friday, 20 June 2003.

Please note that those countries wishing to open an account with the BCH are encouraged to advise the Secretariat of their nominated National Focal Point for the BCH, and an account will be established for them as soon as possible.

(a) Countries with a BCH National Focal Point

If your country has registered a National Focal Point for the BCH, please use your BCH account to register your information in the database directly online by following the procedure outlined below:

- (1) Go to the BCH home page http://bch.biodiv.org and click on "Enter the Management Centre" located under the column "Registering Information".
- (2) Enter your e-mail address and password.
- (3) Click on the link marked "Register new information".
- (4) Under the category "Capacity-Building", click on "Capacity-building needs and Priorities" and proceed to fill the relevant fields.
- (5) You may wish to "Save the draft record" intermittently as you enter the information, particularly if you have an unstable Internet connection.
