Pursuant to decision VI/31 of the sixth meeting of the Conference of the Parties to the Convention on Biological Diversity, and in accordance with rule 7 of the rules of procedure for meetings of the Conference of the Parties, I am pleased to inform you that, at the kind invitation of the Government of Malaysia, the seventh meeting of the Conference of the Parties to the Convention on Biological Diversity (COP-7) will be held in Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia from Monday, 9 to Friday, 20 February 2004. COP-7 meeting will reconvene on Friday, 27 February 2004 to consider certain matters arising from the first meeting of the Conference of the Parties serving as the meeting of the Parties to the Biosafety Protocol (COP/MOP-1), which will also be held at the same venue from Monday, 23 to Friday, 27 February 2004.
